ORDER

The following parties have filed joint applications for approval of interconnection agreements
or amendments to an interconnection agreement:

Application filed May 23, 2024, and an amended application filed May 31, 2024, for approval of an interconnection agreement. |
| Case No. U-21660 | AT&T Michigan and EarthGrid PBC
Application for approval of an interconnection agreement and a first amendment to the interconnection agreement filed May 29, 2024, and request to withdraw the application filed May 29, 2024. The request to withdraw is approved. |
| Case No. U-21664 | Carr Telephone Company and Level 3 Communications, LLC
Application filed June 11, 2024, for approval of a local wireline network interconnection and traffic exchange agreement. |

47 USC 252(e)(2) and (3) provide in part:

- (2) The State commission may only reject
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) of this section if it finds that--
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; . . .

- (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (2), but subject to section 253 of this title, nothing in this section shall prohibit a State commission from establishing or enforcing other requirements of State law in its review of an agreement, including requiring compliance with intrastate telecommunications service quality standards or requirements.

After reviewing the applications, the Commission finds that they should be approved. The Commission finds that the agreements and amendments are consistent with federal and state law and are in the public interest. Under 47 USC 252(i) and MCL 484.2359(2), the services provided under the agreements shall be made available to other telecommunications carriers upon the same terms and conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The interconnection agreements and amendments listed above are approved, and the withdrawal is approved.

- B. Approval of the interconnection agreements and amendments does not alter the duty of the parties to comply with relevant federal and state law and past and future Commission orders and rules.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court under 47 USC 252(e)(6). To comply with the requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
