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This calculation identifies each Load Serving Entity (LSE) serving customers in Michigan’s proportional share of the minimum statewide energy storage target, using peak load information for the previous five years filed in capacity demonstration filings under MCL 460.6w. This calculation was performed by MPSC Staff in accordance with the calculation methodology approved by the Commission in its 1/23/25 Order in Case No. U-21571:

$$Storage\ Target_{LSE} = Storage\ Target_{state} * \left(\frac{Peak\ Avg_{LSE}}{Peak\ Avg_{state}} \right)$$

This calculation is to be used by LSE’s filing either a storage plan or contracts for the necessary qualifying storage facilities in the current year, in accordance with Section 101 of Public Act 235 of 2023, and will therefore be updated annually by Commission Staff to allow for LSE’s filing in that year to use the most recent data. Future updates to this calculation will be filed annually through 2029, in the open docket for LSE capacity demonstration filings, within 30 days after the completion of capacity demonstration filings as required under MCL 460.6w for that year.
