**INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY’S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR FILING 2026-2029 ENERGY WASTE REDUCTION PLAN**

Indiana Michigan Power Company (“I&M” or the “Company”) requests that the Michigan Public Service Commission (“MPSC” or the “Commission”) extend the August 1, 2025 filing date for its 2026-2029 Energy Waste Reduction Plan (“EWR Plan”) to October 1, 2025 to facilitate I&M’s transition to Efficiency United to implement its EWR Plan. The Commission established the current filing date in its November 7, 2024 Order, as revised by the November 14, 2024 in this case (the “Order”). In support of this Motion, I&M respectfully represents:

1. Consistent with Public Act 295 of 2008, as amended, the Commission issued its Order in this case establishing August 1, 2025, as I&M’s due date for filing its 2026-2029 quadrennial EWR Plan. By this Motion, I&M requests the Commission extend the filing date to October 1, 2025.

2. In past years, I&M has filed and the Commission has approved biennial EWR Plans describing how I&M planned to achieve compliance with Act 295, as amended. Those EWR Plans included cost-effective portfolios of residential and commercial EWR programs and pilot programs, and explained how those programs

were to be funded, administered, and evaluated to achieve applicable EWR annual savings standards.

3. After discussions with Commission Staff, the Company has elected to engage the State Administrator, Efficiency United, to implement its EWR programs for the 2026-2029 quadrennial plan period, consistent with the Commission's Order in Case No. U-21654. Staff supports that decision.

4. Although I&M has engaged Efficiency United and Commission Staff, due to the timing of its decision to engage Efficiency United to assist with this programming, I&M is not in a position to meet an August 1, 2025 filing for its EWR Plan.

5. To properly prepare an EWR Plan that incorporates Efficiency United's services and to properly prepare the accompanying surcharge rate factors based on plan budgets developed by Efficiency United, I&M respectfully requests the Commission approve an extension of time for I&M to submit its EWR Plan filing to October 1, 2025.

6. The Company has consulted with Staff and Staff supports this extension for the Company's EWR Plan filing.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, I&M respectfully requests that the Commission extend I&M's deadline for filing its EWR Plan up to October 1, 2025.
