CUSTOMER A’S NOTICE OF NON-OBJECTION REGARDING ATTACHMENT 2

At the hearing held on September 30 on Customer A’s Motion to Quash a Portion of a Discovery Request and Production to Prevent the Improper Disclosure of its Confidential Information (the “Motion to Quash”), the Administrative Law Judge noted that additional materials not discussed by Customer A had been produced by Consumers Energy in response to the Attorney General’s discovery question 159(b), notably a spreadsheet produced as Attachment 2.

Because Customer A had not received Attachment 2 at the time of the hearing, it could not opine as to whether the document contained the kind of information Customer A objected to being disclosed. Consumers Energy agreed to provide Attachment 2 to counsel so that review could be undertaken, and that document is attached to this notice. Additionally, the Attorney General noted at the hearing that its intention was to include Attachment 2, though not the other materials that were the subject of Customer’s A motion, in testimony due in this case. The Attorney General agreed to hold filing Attachment 2 with the testimony, provided that such filing would not be deemed late, in order to allow Customer A an opportunity to review the materials.

Having been provided by Consumers Energy a copy of Attachment 2, Customer A files this notice of non-objection to the production of Attachment 2, and it does not seek to include Attachment 2 as material that is the subject of its Motion to Quash. For the sake of clarity, it also states it has no objection to the inclusion of Attachment 2 by the Attorney General as an exhibit to testimony, and further thanks counsel for the Attorney General for clarifying that the documents that are the subject of the Motion to Quash were not necessary to include to support that testimony.
