SUBJECT: Schedule Suspension, Silver Maple (Solar Siting)

(x) Suspend All Dates*

Discovery: Discovery served prior to July 1, 2026, shall be answered under the discovery turnaround as in the previous June 5, 2026, scheduling memorandum. Discovery is otherwise suspended.

Reason: The Applicant requested suspension of all dates and agreed to waive the 12-month Commission decision deadline while it evaluates measures to address the impacts of the May 7, 2026, Court of Appeals decision in *In Re Implementing Provisions of Public Act 233 of 2023*. Applicant will make a filing once that determination has been made.

Miscellaneous: This Scheduling Memorandum does not prohibit any party from filing a motion prior to the scheduling of new dates. The ALJ may take any necessary action to dispose of such a motion.

The Motion to Dismiss dated July 3, 2026, by the Smallegan intervenors and appearing in the docket as filing U-22071-0158 is held in abeyance pending the applicant's determination on how it intends to proceed. Upon the applicant's filing indicating its decision, the ALJ will consult with the parties to set a revised case schedule or take other appropriate action.
