DTE ELECTRIC COMPANY’S FILING ANNOUNCEMENT

In accordance with MCL 460.6t, MCL 460.6s, and the Commission’s Revised Integrated Resource Plan (“IRP”) Filing Requirements adopted in Case Nos. U-21570 and U-21867, DTE Electric Company (“DTE Electric” or the “Company”) submits this Filing Announcement to provide notice that it intends to file an application for approval of its IRP, approval of a Clean Energy Plan (“CEP”), approvals of Certificates of Necessity (“CON”), and for other requested relief (collectively, the “2026 IRP Filing”). This Filing Announcement is being filed at least 30 calendar days before DTE Electric’s anticipated 2026 IRP Filing on or about September 24, 2026.¹

DTE Electric’s 2026 IRP Filing will include a Clean Energy Plan pursuant to MCL 460.1051 that addresses the Company’s compliance with Michigan’s Clean Energy Standard and Renewable Portfolio Standard, the Company’s share of the Statewide Energy Storage Target, and the Company’s evaluation of renewable energy resources, energy storage resources, energy waste reduction programs, demand-side resources, and other clean energy measures.

As part of the 2026 IRP Filing, the Company will seek approval of Certificates of

Necessity pursuant to MCL 460.6s for two new dispatchable generation facilities intended to support long-term system reliability and resource adequacy, including compliance with applicable planning reserve requirements as existing generation resources retire and customer demand for electricity evolves:

- An approximately 700 MW combined cycle natural gas turbine generating facility to be located in Michigan
- An approximately 1,400 MW combined cycle natural gas turbine generating facility to be located in Michigan

During the development of its 2026 IRP and CEP, the Company conducted broad stakeholder engagement with customers, environmental justice communities, community leaders, local organizations, and technical stakeholders to inform the development of the plans. These activities occurred between April 2025 and June 2026 through multiple engagement methods and channels:

- Eleven community-based engagement events that reached 10 environmental justice communities.
- Three virtual information sessions.
- A quantitative “Voice of the Customer” survey of more than 1,500 residential and business customers, and community representatives.
- Four public meetings, three of which were held in-person in environmental justice communities.
- Materials from public meetings were made available at dtecleanenergy.com.
- More than 40 organizations were invited to participate in five technical workshops.
- Maintained an email address contact and comment form on the dtecleanenergy.com website.

The Company will continue to engage interested stakeholders throughout the Commission’s review of the 2026 IRP Filing and the associated proceedings.

Additional information regarding the proposed facilities, including supporting testimony, analyses, exhibits, and the Company’s requested approvals, will be provided as part of the 2026 IRP Filing in accordance with MCL 460.6t, MCL 460.6s, and the Commission’s IRP Filing Requirements.

This Filing Announcement is being served, together with proof of service, on all parties granted intervention in DTE Electric's most recent Integrated Resource Plan case and its two most recent electric rate cases.
