ORDER

On July 27, 2000, CMS Energy Resource Management Company (f/k/a CMS Marketing, Services and Trading Company) (CMS Energy) submitted an application, pursuant to the Customer Choice and Electricity Reliability Act, 2000 PA 141, MCL 460.10 *et seq.*, for a license as an alternative electric supplier (AES). In an order dated August 17, 2000 in Case No. U-12563, the Commission approved CMS Energy’s AES license in the state of Michigan.

On February 8, 2010, CMS Energy requested the voluntary relinquishment of its AES license. The Commission Staff recommends approval of this request because CMS Energy has no retail

electric customers in Michigan and has indicated that it has no intention to commence operation in the future.

The Commission finds that CMS Energy's request for voluntary relinquishment of its AES license should be approved.

Because the Commission approves CMS Energy's request to voluntarily relinquish its AES license in Case No. U-12653, the Commission finds that CMS Energy shall be relieved of its obligations to comply with the reporting requirements for AESs as well as the new requirements established by Public Acts 286 and 295 of 2008 and the Commission's implementation orders. The Commission directs the Commission's Executive Secretary to close Case No. U-15827.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. CMS Energy Resource Management Company's license as an alternative electric supplier in the State of Michigan is hereby rescinded.

B. CMS Energy Resource Management Company is relieved of any obligation to comply with the reporting requirements for alternative electric suppliers and the new requirements established by Public Acts 286 and 295 of 2008 and the Commission's implementation orders.

C. The Commission's Executive Secretary is authorized to close Case No. U-15827.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
