



The Michigan Public Service Commission will hold a public hearing to consider the April 1, 2002, joint request of Cherryland Electric Cooperative, Great Lakes Energy Cooperative, Presque Isle Electric & Gas Co-op, and Homeworks Tri-County Electric Cooperative to approve reconciliation of their 2001 power supply costs. The Cooperatives' 2001 PSCR over/undercollections are as follows:

Great Lakes-Boyne	(1,045,963) undercollection
Great Lakes-Newaygo	1,118,184 overcollection

HomeWorks Tri-County	229,177 overcollection
Presque Isle	(195,154) undercollection

The Commission has selected this case for participation in its Electronic Filings program. All documents filed in this case must be submitted in both paper and electronic versions. Any person wishing to intervene in the case shall file an original and four copies of a petition to intervene and an electronic copy in portable document format (PDF) with this Commission by May 30, 2002. The proof of service shall indicate service upon the Cooperatives' attorney, Ms. Christine Mason Soneral, at Dykema Gossett PLLC, 800 Michigan National Tower, Lansing, Michigan 48933. Any person who intends to intervene and become a party to this case may immediately begin formal discovery, if desired, of the Cooperatives.

A member of the public who wishes to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file the appearance, you must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of your wish to make a statement of position.
