

### NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE CUSTOMERS OF EDISON SAULT ELECTRIC COMPANY CASE NO. U-13563-R

Edison Sault Electric Company may collect \$354,409 from customers as a result of an under collection of 2003 power supply costs, if the Michigan Public Service Commission approves of its request.

The information below describes how a person may participate in this case.

The Commission has selected this case for participation in its Paperless Electronic Filings Pilot Program. The Commission recognizes that some residential customers may not have the computer equipment or access to the Internet necessary to submit documents electronically. Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall file a petition to Intervene with this Commission by May 13, 2004. (Residential customers may file petitions to intervene using the traditional paper format.) Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file the appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of their wish to make a statement of position.
