WASHINGTON 10 STORAGE CORPORATION

CASE NO. U-14529

- Washington 10 Storage Corporation request approval to increase the maximum stabilized wellhead pressure of its storage facility, and to construct and operate a lateral pipeline in Macomb County, Michigan, if the Michigan Public Service Commission grants it a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the May 26, 2005 application of Washington 10 Storage Corporation for authorization to increase the maximum stabilized wellhead pressure of the storage field located in Washington Township and the Village of Romeo, Michigan from 1,900 psig to 2,122 psig. Washington 10 Storage Corporation is also seeking ex parte approval of the construction and operation of a 2,200-foot/24-inch lateral pipeline to loop an existing pipeline extending from the Washington 10 compression station site to interconnect with Michigan Consolidated Gas Company and Vector Pipeline Company.

The Commission has selected this case for participation in its Electronic Filings Program. The Commission recognizes that some residential customers may not have the computer equipment or access to the Internet necessary to submit documents electronically.
