



PETITION TO INTERVENE OF  
JORDAN DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, L.L.C.

NOW COMES Jordan Development Company, L.L.C. ("Jordan"), by  
and through its attorneys, Worman, Dixon & Manis, P.L.C., and in support  
of its Petition to Intervene filed pursuant to R 460.17201, states as  
follows:

1. Jordan is a Michigan limited liability company organized  
and doing business under the laws of the State of Michigan. Jordan owns  
oil and gas interests in the areas near and around the pipeline proposed  
to be operated by Major Pipeline LLC ("Major").

2. On November 29, 2005, Major filed an Application with the  
Commission requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity  
to Construct and Operate the proposed pipeline.

3. Jordan has an interest in Major's requested certification  
as Jordan presently operates two (2) wells within a two mile radius of  
Major's proposed pipeline.

4. In addition, Jordan has substantial monetary investment  
in approximately ten thousand acres of oil and gas leasehold located near  
and around a portion of the proposed pipeline.

5. Depending on the rates, terms and conditions of service,  
Jordan may have its Antrim gas transported on the Major pipeline. As a

potential transporter of Antrim Gas on the Major pipeline, Jordan falls within the "zone of interests" protected by 1929 PA 9 ("Act 9"). (See U-9852, December 5, 1991, Opinion & Order, p 3, n 2, "interests to be protected by Act 9 are limited to those held by utility customers, transportation customers, gas producers, land owners with property in the path of the proposed pipeline, and residents of the state who possess particular environmental concerns ...")

6. Jordan is subject to "injury in fact". Jordan has a direct and vested economic interest in having its gas production transported by a pipeline that is cost effective, efficient, safe and reliable. The failure of any of these elements could cause direct and substantial injury to Jordan's ability to develop and to market its gas production.

7. The Application of Major indicates that transportation services will be offered at an average rate of \$0.548 per MCF. The proposed rates however are based upon certain assumptions set out in the application. Until the testimony to be presented has been reviewed, Jordan is not able to determine its final position. However, Jordan intends to participate in this proceeding and support the establishment of a pipeline which provides for the transportation of Antrim Gas with rates which are economical, reasonable and prudent.

8. Jordan has a substantial interest in these proceedings; no other party is in a position to protect its substantial interest or to assert and establish, from its viewpoint, its interests and to protect it from any adverse consequences. Jordan is, therefore, a necessary and essential party and denial of Jordan's Petition would be detrimental to

Jordan and would violate Jordan's right to due process and equal protection.

WHEREFORE, Jordan respectfully requests that this Commission:

A. Grant Jordan's petition to intervene and accord it the rights of a full party to this proceeding with the opportunity to file both direct and rebuttal testimony, to cross-examine any witness offered and produced by any other party to these proceedings, to submit exhibits and take such other action as permitted any other party, and for such other relief as may be suitable to enable Jordan to present its position.

B. Grant such further and additional relief as may be lawful and proper.
