**PETITION OF CALUMET ELECTRONICS
CORPORATION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

Calumet Electronics Corporation ("Calumet") respectfully requests leave to intervene in the above-captioned matter pursuant to MPSC Rule 201, R 460.17201. In support of its request, Calumet states:

1. Calumet is a private, for-profit corporation incorporated in Michigan since November 6, 1967.
2. Calumet is located in Calumet, Michigan and receives electric service from Upper Peninsula Power Company ("UPPCo") under Rate WP-1D, the large light and power distribution rate. According to information recently supplied by UPPCo, Calumet is one of UPPCo's 20 largest purchasers of electric energy over the past three years, as measured in kw-hours. As such, electric costs are a significant part of Calumet's annual operating expenses.
3. Calumet has previously intervened in UPPCo's rate case (Case U-14410), UPPCo's 2004 PSCR reconciliation case (U-13904-R), UPPCo's rate increase request case (U-14745), UPPCo's 2006 PSCR plan case (U-14706) and UPPCO's 2007 PSCR plan case (U-15006). The significant costs associated with UPPCo's rates, and its

impact on Calumet's operating expenses, have made it essential that Calumet intervene in this matter for the purpose of trying to reduce those electric costs.

4. As an UPPCo customer and rate-payer, Calumet has been and will continue to be directly affected by the matters at issue in this rate proceeding. Accordingly, Calumet has an interest which entitles it to intervene and participate fully in this proceeding.

5. If leave to intervene is granted, Calumet anticipates participating in all phases of this proceeding, including discovery, cross-examination and the submission of briefs and reply briefs. Calumet reserves the right to propose its own direct testimony, including expert testimony as necessary, and to take such positions as appropriate during the course of these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Calumet respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission:

- A. Grant leave to intervene as requested herein; and
- B. Grant such further and additional relief as may be lawful and proper.
