ORDER

On August 5, 2008, AT&T Michigan and Ygnition Networks, Inc., (Ygnition) filed a joint application requesting approval of a seventh amendment to the interconnection agreement between the parties approved by the Commission on January 30, 2007. By letter dated September 18, 2008, the Commission’s Telecommunications Division informed Ygnition that it is not in the public interest to grant the application because the company is no longer registered with the Department of Energy, Labor & Economic Growth to do business in Michigan, and is not registered with the Intrastate Telecommunications Service Provider Database. *See*, 47 USC 252(e)(2)(A)(ii). The letter informed Ygnition that the application would be held in abeyance until proper registration is established. A further letter to Ygnition dated April 2, 2009, requested again that proper registration to do business in Michigan be established by May 4, 2009.

Proper registration has not been established and the Commission finds that the application should be dismissed for lack of progress, without prejudice to filing a new application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the August 5, 2008 application filed by AT&T Michigan and Ygnition Networks, Inc., for a seventh amendment to an interconnection agreement is dismissed without prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court pursuant to 47 USC 252(e)(6).
