Winn Restructuring, Inc. ("WRI") has filed an Application with the Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) pursuant to §§ 301 and 302 of the Michigan Telecommunications Act, 1991 PA 179, as amended, requesting that the Commission issue WRI a temporary and permanent license to provide local exchange service in the Winn exchange and all the zones and exchange areas of AT&T and Verizon throughout the State of Michigan. The Commission will hold an evidentiary hearing to consider WRI's request for a temporary and permanent license.

The Commission will hold an evidentiary hearing to consider WRI's request for a temporary and permanent license. WRI will have the burden of proving that it possesses

sufficient technical, financial and managerial resources and abilities to provide telecommunications services within the requested geographic areas, and that the granting of the requested license will not be contrary to the public interest.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall file a petition to intervene with the Commission by November 2, 2007. The proof of service shall indicate service upon WRI's attorney, Mr. Ronald W. Bloomberg at Miller, Canfield, Paddock and Stone, PLC, One Michigan Avenue, Suite 900, Lansing, Michigan, 48933.

Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file the appearance, you must attend the hearing and advise the presiding Administrative Law Judge of your wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information available on the Commission's Web site and subject to disclosure.

Requests for adjournment must be made pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure R 460.17315 and R 460.17335. Request for further information on adjournments should be directed to (517) 241-6060.
