



PARTICIPATION: Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the August 17, 2010 application of Alpena Power Company's (Alpena), which requests that the Commission approve its reconciliation of amounts expensed and revenues collected under its Renewable Energy Plan approved by the Commission in Case No. U-15 804, for the 12-month period ending December 31, 2009. Alpena is not requesting any revenue adjustment.

All documents filed in this case shall be submitted electronically through the Commission's E-Dockets Website at: michigan.gov/mpscdockets. Requirements and instructions for filing can be found in the User Manual on the E-Dockets help page. Documents may also be submitted, in Word or PDF format, as an attachment to an email sent to mpscdockets@michigan.gov. If you require assistance prior to e-filing, contact Commission staff at (517) 241-6180 or by e-mail at mpscdockets@michigan.gov.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by October 19, 2010. (Interested persons may elect to file using the traditional paper format.) The proof of service shall indicate service upon Alpena's attorney, James D. Florip, at Gillard, Bauer, Mazrum, Florip, Smigelski, & Gulden, 109 E. Chishlom Street, Alpena, Michigan 49707.

Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his/her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.

Requests for adjournment must be made pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure R 460.17315 and R 460.17335. Requests for further information on adjournment should be directed to (517) 241-6060.
