*A Resolution In Support Of Requesting the Michigan Public
Service Commission to Reassess Opt-out Fees for Smart Meter or
Advanced Metering Infrastructure Programs*

*Commissioner James L. Carabelli, on Behalf of the Board of Commissioners,
Offers the Following Resolution:*

*Whereas, the Macomb County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 2012-6
in support of requesting the Michigan Public Service Commission to investigate
the safety and effectiveness of Smart Meters; and*

*Whereas, , since the adoption of Resolution 2012-6, Macomb County residents have
voiced health concerns regarding Smart Meters and its opt-out fees; and*


*Whereas, the Michigan Public Service Commission has approved the
implementation of smart meters or AMI devices in Michigan and the associated
fees for customers who choose to opt-out of the installation of a smart meter in the
form of a one-time fee that is either pre-installation or post-installation, in
conjunction with a monthly charge for outing-out in perpetuity; and*

*Whereas, the Michigan Public Service Commission, when establishing the opt-out
fees, provided no provision for low income customers who want to opt out of the
smart meter installation but who cannot afford the additional fees.*


*Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Macomb County Board of Commissioners
hereby expresses its concern relative to the current opt-out fees approved by the
Michigan Public Service Commission for Advanced Metering Infrastructure in
Michigan.*

*Be It Further Resolved that the Macomb County Board of Commissioners requests
that the Michigan Public Services Commission reassess the fees associated with
opting- out and the ability for consumers to keep their current analog meters.*


