**AMENDED APPLICATION OF AIRNORTH COMMUNICATIONS, INC.
REQUESTING DESIGNATION AS AN ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS
CARRIER IN THE ETC SERVICED AREA**

Introduction

AirNorth Communications, Inc. (“AirNorth”), a Michigan corporation, pursuant to Section 214 (e)(2) and Section 254 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 USC 214 (e)(2) and 245, and Sections 201 and 203 of the Michigan Telecommunications Act (“MTA”), as amended, MCL 484.2201 and 484.2203, respectively, the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) including 47 CFR 54.202, and the Michigan Public Service Commission’s (“MPSC”) December 20, 2012 and January 17, 2013 Orders in Case Nos. U-14535, U-17182, hereby applies to the MPSC for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) within its respective service areas in Michigan as identified in Exhibit A (“ETC Service Area”), the reasons set forth below.

This Application addresses all the requirements for ETC status as set forth in the MPSC’s December 20, 2012 and January 17, 2013 Orders in the case numbers mentioned in the preceding paragraph. AirNorth’s representations in this Appellation are limited to its proposed operations in

the ETC Service Area. Based on the information in this Application, AirNorth respectfully requests the following from the MPSC:

1. An order designating AirNorth as an ETC in the ETC Service Area for the purpose of receiving Connect America Funds (formerly known as High-Cost Support) and Lifeline federal universal service support; and
2. An order, minute action, or other action by the MPSC which sets forth the appropriate ETC certification to the FCC so that AirNorth may receive additional federal universal service support, including Connect America Fund support in the ETC Service Area; and
3. An order granting such other relief as may be necessary and appropriate.

As discussed in more detail below, AirNorth meets the statutory and regulatory requirements for designation as an ETC and is able and prepared to offer Lifeline support services for high cost loops throughout the ETC Service Area. The designation of AirNorth as an ETC in Michigan will promote the public interest by providing eligible low-income consumers a choice for their Lifeline telecommunications needs, resulting in a high level of service quality and low prices for Lifeline service in Michigan.

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I. STATEMENT OF FACTS

AirNorth is a local facilities based provider of wireless and wireline high speed broadband Internet, voice, messaging, and data services capable of reaching all eligible consumers throughout the State of Michigan. AirNorth currently offers and markets wireless high speed broadband Internet, voice, messaging, data services and re-sale business telephone services within the State of Michigan (“AirNorth Services”). AirNorth is in the process of deploying an advanced telecommunications network known as CyberBand™, capable of serving consumers’ basic and advanced telecommunications needs.

AirNorth submitted its Application for its Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (“CLEC”) license with the MPSC on November 12, 2014. Its CLEC Application has been set for evidentiary hearing by the Commission on January 8, 2015. To date, no opposition has been filed to the Application.

AirNorth is a Michigan corporation with principal offices at 2732 Orchard Beach Road, Cheboygan, MI 49721. Upon issuance of the CLEC License, AirNorth will provide AirNorth Services to customers in the ETC Service Area. AirNorth currently provides wireless high speed broadband Internet and voice services to approximately 240 customers in Cheboygan County. It also is an AT&T wholesaler of telephone services to business customers in Cheboygan and Emmitt Counties.

AirNorth will provide telecommunications services in the State of Michigan. AirNorth will provide domestic voice and data services, primarily to low income consumers. As a reseller of wireless services, AirNorth purchases wireline transmission facilities from AT&T Michigan on a wholesale basis and resells these services to its customers, including calling and text messaging, along with user-friendly, high quality customer service. AirNorth’s products and plans will be specifically geared toward servicing low income communities, and its service models and pricing

plans will reflect this mission. The Company will not require service contracts from its customers and it will always ensure competitively low pricing for its services and products. By providing affordable services, AirNorth can reach out to those who are often ignored by traditional carriers.

AirNorth will manage all aspects of the customer experience, including setting service pricing, marketing materials, and live customer service. The Company's budget-friendly pricing will give many low-income consumers the option of having basic telecommunications service without the burden of hidden costs, varying monthly phone service, or contractual commitments.

AirNorth's customer base will likely be low-income and the majorities are unlikely to have phone service of any kind prior to enrollment. AirNorth's customers will depend on and benefit greatly from AirNorth's inexpensive and flexible pricing plans. AirNorth will not impose credit checks nor will it require any deposits or contractual commitments. AirNorth will reach out to the low-income sector of the customer base to offer attractive and affordable communications options. As such, AirNorth will contribute to the expansion of telecommunications services for low-income consumers.

AirNorth respectfully requests the MPSC to grant this Application and designate it as an ETC in the ETC Service Area for the purpose of its receipt of Universal Service Fund ("USF") support. Under 47 USC 214 (2)(5), a "service area" is the geographical area established by the State Commission for the purpose of determining universal service obligations and support mechanisms. The ETC Service Area qualifies for such designation.

II. AIRNORTH'S FIVE YEAR BUSINESS PLAN FOR HIGH COST SUPPORT 47 CFR 54.202(a)

AirNorth certifies that it will use any high cost federal USF support that it receives only for the provision, construction, maintenance and upgrading of facilities and provision of support

in the ETC Service Area for which such support is intended. The USF support that AirNorth receives will help maintain affordable rates for local exchange services and construct the telecommunications facilities and equipment necessary to meet evolving service requirements and maintain a high quality service in the ETC Service Area. Following the granting of AirNorth's CLEC Application, AirNorth will enter into interconnect agreements with the incumbent local exchange carriers and immediately construct and equip its facilities in order to provide telecommunications services to all customers in the ETC Service Area.

On December 5, 2014, AirNorth was named a provisional recipient of a \$2.4 M grant pursuant to the FCC Rural Broadband Experiment (the "Grant"). AirNorth's five (5) year plan revolves around the eighteen (18) census tracks in Charlevoix, Emmitt and Cheboygan Counties that are funded by the Grant. (See Exhibit B – FCC Public Notice to Provisional Winners of Bid Process). These census tracks have been designated by the FCC as "unserved" or "underserved" geographical areas for its Broadband Experiment Grants program.

In addition, over the next five (5) years, AirNorth will construct, equip and operate facilities pursuant to its CLEC license in Charlevoix, Emmet, Cheboygan and Presque Isle Counties in the Northern Lower Peninsula of Michigan. There are no other providers as defined by the FCC in these areas. AirNorth will construct, equip, operate and manage facilities in these areas to bring affordable telecommunications services to residents who are unserved or underserved in these areas. This service area consists of approximately 68,000 residences and 98,000 people.

Because AirNorth is a new entrant into telecommunications services in the ETC Service Area, it has never before received USF support in the ETC Service Area, it has never failed to meet any deadline in any five (5) year plan, it has not experienced any outages lasting 30 minutes or longer, nor that were required to be reported under former Rule 23 of the MPSC's now rescinded

Quality of Service Rules, (2000 AC, R 484.523).

AirNorth has not failed to provide service to potential customers, nor received any complaints from any customers in the ETC Service Area.

III. DEMONSTRATION OF FUNCTIONALITY IN EMERGENCIES 47 CFR 54.202(a)(2)

AirNorth will be functional in an emergency situation in the ETC Service Area through the use of backup power to ensure functionality without an external power source. AirNorth will have backup battery reserve in its central office, which will enable it to provide service for a minimum of eight (8) hours. AirNorth will also comply with all obligations to provide service and have emergency backup power as required in Section 305 (c) of the MTA, MCL 484.2305c. AirNorth's network will be engineered to provide maximum capacity in order to handle excess traffic in the event of traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations.

As discussed, AirNorth, through interconnect agreements, will utilize the extensive and well established Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC) network and facilities to provide AirNorth's telecommunications services. The Company believes that these telecommunications networks are capable of managing traffic spikes that may occur during emergency situations and can reroute traffic in the event of damaged facilities. AirNorth also understands that each carrier has a reasonable amount of back-up power to ensure functionality in power outages. These ILEC telecommunications services will provide the same functionality to AirNorth and AirNorth's customers as these carriers provide to themselves and their own customers.

IV. CONSUMER PROTECTION 47 CFR 54.202(a)(3)

AirNorth will satisfy applicable consumer protection and service quality standards in

accordance with 47 CFR Section 54.202(a)(3). The FCC has stated that a wireless petitioner's commitment to comply with the CTIA - The Wireless Association's Consumer Code for Wireless Service, will satisfy this requirement. AirNorth commits to comply with the CITA Consumer Code to ensure that the Company offers its subscribers the highest level of protection and quality service.

AirNorth's pledge to provide quality service and to comply with the CTIA Consumer Code evidences AirNorth's commitment to satisfy all of the consumer protection and service quality standards applicable to Lifeline services. The Company will make every effort to expeditiously resolve complaints received by the Commission and will designate a specific contact person to work with Commission staff to resolve any complaints or other compliance issues.

AirNorth will service all consumers within its ETC Service Area, and certifies that it will comply with the service requirements applicable to the low-income support that is consistent with 47 CFR Section 54.202(a)(1)(i).

AirNorth will comply with all applicable Michigan specific requirements for a competitive facilities-based wireless Lifeline services.

AirNorth will comply with all applicable Commission and FCC requirements with respect to fees, charges, and reports. The Company will not collect service deposits for its plans and will not charge a number-portability fee for Lifeline accounts.

AirNorth will timely pay all applicable Federal, State, and local regulatory fees, including Universal Service and E911 fees

V. ADDITIONAL STEPS TO BE TAKEN TO PREVENT WASTE, FRAUD AND ABUSE

AirNorth recognizes the importance of safeguarding the universal service system and

preventing any fraud, waste, and abuse. As such, AirNorth will implement numerous safeguards to protect the integrity of the system, including the following:

Detailed Customer Enrollment Process. AirNorth will follow the same processes for the enrollment of all subscribers who elect AirNorth's Lifeline offering and qualify for Lifeline. By doing so, AirNorth will be able to ensure that its enrollment and verification practices meet the needs of all customers, in a variety of situations, while recognizing that it must maintain strict compliance with all applicable requirements. In general, AirNorth will use the following four (4) step process to enroll customers in Lifeline, which help prevent any fraud, waste and abuse of the universal service system:

1. Customer submits application for Lifeline services with the required documentation (e.g. documentation verifying eligibility to participate in a qualifying program or documentation of income based qualification if elected by the consumer). See Exhibit C.
2. AirNorth reviews the application to ensure that:
 - a) the application is complete and the consumer properly qualifies for Lifeline based on information provided, including (i) whether the customer address is within ETC Service Area; and (ii) answers the following statements:
 - I, or a member of my household, currently receive Lifeline assistance at the above address.
 - b) the customer has signed the application, reflecting their acknowledgement of attestations, including the following:
 - I certify that the information provided on this application is true and correct. I acknowledge that providing false or fraudulent information in order to receive Lifeline assistance is punishable by law.
 - AirNorth may release any records (including financial records) required for the administration of the Lifeline programs.
 - I understand that I may be required to verify my continued eligibility for Lifeline assistance at any time and that failure to do so will result in termination of Lifeline assistance. I agree to notify AirNorth within five (5) business days if I become ineligible to receive Lifeline Assistance.
 - I understand that Lifeline assistance is only available for one wireline or wireless phone line per address. If I currently receive Lifeline assistance, I agree to notify my current Lifeline service provider that I have applied to receive Lifeline assistance from AirNorth.

3. Customer acknowledges their commitment to activate or convert an existing line to the Lifeline; and
4. AirNorth activates service and/or converts an existing line of service to the Lifeline plan.

Customer Verification Process. AirNorth will follow all applicable requirements to annually verify the continued eligibility of its Lifeline subscribers. AirNorth will utilize procedures to verify an individual's continuing eligibility for both program and income-based criteria consistent with the FCC's requirements in 47 CFR Sections 54.409 and 54.410, which includes:

1. Identifying the appropriate sample of its Michigan Lifeline subscribership who will be asked to verify their continued eligibility for Lifeline;
2. Notifying each selected Michigan Lifeline subscriber in writing of their obligation to verify their continued eligibility and allow each subscriber sixty (60) days to provide such documentation;
3. Providing each Michigan Lifeline subscriber who fails to properly certify their continued eligibility written notice of discontinuance of Lifeline service thirty (30) days thereafter (during which time AirNorth will not claim reimbursement for any Lifeline support provided); and,
4. Removing the Lifeline discount from any Michigan subscriber's account for whom the subscriber does not respond and properly certify their continued eligibility.

Additionally, AirNorth will maintain records to document compliance with these requirements and will provide the Commission with a copy of the Annual Certification and Verification that it submits to the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") in which the Company will certify that it has completed the eligibility verification described above and that it complies with all requirements related to enrolling consumers who qualify for Lifeline based solely on income.

VI. AIRNORTH WILL PROVIDE SERVICE THROUGHOUT THE ETC SERVICE AREA

Sections 214(e)(2) and 214(e)(5) of the Act provide that ETC designations shall be made for a service area, defined as a geographic area established by the state commission. The Company seeks certification to operate as an ETC in the geographic service areas throughout Michigan where its underlying carriers, namely, AT&T Michigan, Frontier North, Inc., CenturyTel of Michigan, Inc., CenturyTel Midwest, Inc., CenturyTel of Northern Michigan, Inc., and CenturyTel of Upper Michigan, Inc. provide coverage.

AirNorth will provide such service in the Charlevoix, Emmitt, Cheboygan and Presque Isle counties service areas beginning no later than 45 days after Connect America funds become available. Local usage plans will not differ in the ETC Service Area.

Phone features are set forth in AirNorth's web site located at www.airnorth.net/phone.

VII. LOCAL USAGE 47 CFR 54.202(a)(4)

An ETC must demonstrate the ability to offer local usage plans comparable to the incumbent local exchange carriers in the areas where designation is sought.

AirNorth will adopt and implement such policies and plans that are designed to openly comply with the following principles of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, namely:

1. Promote the availability of quality services at just, reasonable and affordable rates for all customers;
2. Increase nationwide access to advanced telecommunications services;
3. Advance the availability of such services to all consumers, including those of low income, rural, insular, and high cost areas, at rates that are reasonably comparable to those charged in urban areas;
4. Increase access to telecommunications and advanced services in schools, libraries and rural health care facilities; and,
5. Provide equitable and non-discriminatory contributions from all providers of telecommunications services for the fund supporting universal service programs.

AirNorth provides each of the services supported by Federal universal service support mechanisms and will provide toll-limitation service for qualifying low-income consumers upon designation as an ETC as set forth below.

1. Voice Grade Access To The Public Switched Telephone Network — The FCC has stated that voice-grade access consists of the ability for a user to take and receive telephone calls within a specified bandwidth.” AirNorth will provide this service via resale of telecommunications services to low income customers in the ETC Service Area.
2. Local Usage – The Company will offer two (2) basic Lifeline service packages throughout the ETC Service Area except to any eligible resident of tribal lands located in the ETC Service Area. In addition, AirNorth will offer two (2) plans that are only available to eligible residents of tribal lands. The Company’s four Lifeline Programs are listed below:
 - i. 125 anytime prepaid minutes per month, with rollover, and with text messaging assessed at a rate of one (1) minute per text message for sending and one 1 minute per text message for receiving text messages.
 - ii. 250 anytime prepaid minutes per month, without rollover, and with text messaging assessed at a rate of 1/3rd minute per text message for sending and 1/3rd minute per text message for receiving text messages.
 - iii. Tribal Resident Lifeline Unlimited Plan. Each month the customer will receive unlimited anytime voice minutes for 500 per month plus fees and taxes. Text messaging will not be available with this plan as minutes are unlimited. This plan will only be available to eligible residents of tribal lands.
 - iv. Tribal Resident Lifeline 100 Plan. Each month the customer will receiving 1,000 anytime voice minutes or 1,000 text messages for 1,000 per month plus fees and taxes. Text messaging will be assessed at a rate of 1/3rd minute per text message for sending and 1/3rd minute per text message for receiving text messages. There are no rollover minutes with this plan. Unused minutes will expire each month on the service expiration date. This plan will only be available to eligible residents of tribal lands.
3. Access To Emergency Services – access to emergency services includes both access to 911 and E911 services to the extent the local government have implemented such services. AirNorth meets this requirement by providing 911 services and meeting all requests for E911 service from local public service answering points (PSAPs).
4. Toll Limitation For Qualifying Low-Income Consumers — toll limitation means both

toll blocking and toll control, or, if a carrier is not capable of providing both toll blocking and toll control, then toll limitation is defined as either toll blocking or toll control. Upon implementing its Lifeline service offering, AirNorth will offer toll limitation to qualifying low income consumers at no additional charge.

VIII. EQUAL ACCESS 47 CFR 54.202 (a)(5)

AirNorth acknowledges that it may be required to provide equal access to long distance carriers in the event that no other ETC is providing equal access within the ETC Service Area. AirNorth will also function as a carrier of last resort in the ETC Service Area, to the extent required by applicable law.

IX. AIRNORTH WILL ADVERTISE THE AVAILABILITY OF ITS LOW INCOME OFFERINGS AND CHARGES FOR SUCH OFFERINGS USING MEDIA OF GENERAL DISTRIBUTION

AirNorth will advertise the availability of and charges for, its low income service offerings using media of general distribution, and will undertake outreach initiatives to increase consumer awareness of AirNorth's Lifeline service offering, consistent with all applicable requirements. AirNorth will use the appropriate media outlets to advertise its universal service offerings in a manner consistent with applicable requirements.

AirNorth will comply with the FCC's rules regarding information to be included in marketing materials, including FCC revised rule section 54.405(c). Specifically, AirNorth's marketing materials will state, in easily understood language, that: (i) the service is a Lifeline; (ii) Lifeline is a government assistance program; (iii) the service may not be transferred to someone else; (iv) consumers must meet certain eligibility requirements before enrolling in the Lifeline programs; (v) the Lifeline programs permit only one Lifeline discount per household; (vi) documentation is necessary for enrollment; and (vii) AirNorth is the provider for the services. Moreover, AirNorth's Lifeline application/certification form will state that Lifeline is a federal benefit and those consumers who willfully make a false statement in order to obtain the lifeline

benefit can be punished by fine or imprisonment or can be barred from the program. AirNorth's Compliance Plan contains an example of the type of advertising material that AirNorth intends to use in ETC applications. AirNorth's advertising materials are attached herein as Exhibit D.

X. OTHER ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

AirNorth commits to offer the following services and functionalities as part of voice telephony as defined in 47 CFR 54.101 required for designation as an ETC in the ETC Service Area:

1. Voice grade access to Public Switched Telephone Network ("PSTN"): AirNorth will provide voice-grade access to the PTSN that will allow its customers in the ETC Service Area to make and receive calls on the PTSN.
2. Local Usage: Minutes of use for local service in the ETC Service Area provided at no additional charge, and unlimited minutes per month in local calling throughout the ETC Service Area.
3. Access to emergency services via a 0-1-1 and E-9-1-1 provided by local governmental or other public safety organizations.
4. Toll limitations for qualifying low income customers.

XI. DESIGNATING AIRNORTH AS AN ETC IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST

Designation of AirNorth as an ETC for Lifeline purposes will further the Commission's universal goals and thus benefit Michigan consumers. Specifically, the Company will offer low cost AirNorth services to low-income consumers, thereby increasing consumer choice. Further, granting of the Petition will provide consumers with access to high quality service and the benefits of AirNorth services. AirNorth Services will be particularly attractive to Lifeline eligible consumers who may frequently change residences or work in migratory jobs. Wireless service offers a stable contact method where traditional landline service would be unavailable or not a viable option. AirNorth's services are an especially attractive option for low-income consumers because it alleviates customer concerns regarding hidden costs, varying monthly charges and long

term contract issues.

Furthermore, granting of this Petition will allow AirNorth to increase public awareness of the availability of the Lifeline programs by: (i) advertising the availability of this Lifeline offerings; and (ii) undertake outreach initiatives aimed at eligible low-income consumers.

XII. REQUEST FOR EX PARTE TREATMENT

This Application may be approved and the requested ETC designation may be made without the time and expense of a hearing under Section 203(1) of the MTA. Pursuant to 203(7), this Application "contain[s] all information, testimony, exhibits, or other documents and information within [AirNorth's] possession on which [AirNorth] intends to rely to support the application." Neither the MTA nor any other law requires that a hearing be held. Pursuant to Section 203(10) of the MTA, "the Commission shall issue a final order in a case filed under this section within 90 days from the date the application...is filed." In other cases involving designations as ETCs, the Commission concluded that it need not solicit comment on the application for designation as an ETC since it would only further delay the application. Therefore, no notice of hearing is required.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, AirNorth respectfully requests that the MPSC:

- A. Issue an order designation AirNorth as an ETC in the ETC Service Area for the purpose of receiving high cost and Lifeline Federal universal service support; and,
- B. Issue an order, minute action, or other action by the MPSC which sets forth the appropriate ETC certification to the FCC so that AirNorth may receive additional Federal universal fund service support, including high cost support in the ETC Service Area; and
- C. Issue an order granting such other relief as may be necessary or appropriate.

On November 7, 2014, the Federal Communications Commission closed the application window for the rural broadband experiments. By this date, applicants were required to complete FCC Form 5610 and attach project bid forms, a descriptive data form listing all of their proposed projects, and certain other project information.¹ Subsequently, the FCC Auction System ranked the submitted bids meeting requirements for the rural broadband experiments from the most cost-effective to the least cost-effective within each funding category.

This Public Notice announces the bidders that have been provisionally selected for funding in each category, subject to the post-selection review process. Each identified bidder must complete certain steps in order to be authorized to receive Connect America Fund support for its rural broadband experiment.

Attachment A provides summary information concerning the provisionally selected bidders, including the number of project bids, the states in which these proposed projects are located, the total amount of support requested for these projects, and the total number of census blocks covered by these projects.² These bidders are seeking support to serve diverse geographic areas with different cost characteristics. Collectively, they have bid on support to cover 26,867 census blocks in 25 states and Puerto Rico³:

- 19 entities seeking support to build networks that are capable of delivering 100 Mbps downstream and 25 Mbps upstream to all locations⁴ in the project census blocks in Arkansas, California, Colorado, Delaware, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, and Texas.⁵
- 12 entities seeking support to build networks capable of delivering 10 Mbps downstream and 1 Mbps upstream to all locations in the project census blocks in Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, North Carolina, Ohio, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, and Washington.
- 9 entities seeking support to build networks capable of delivering 10 Mbps downstream and 1 Mbps upstream to all locations in project census blocks that are extremely costly to serve in California, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, North Dakota, Kansas, South Dakota, and Texas.

With the release of this Public Notice, the post-selection review process for these bidders now begins. The Bureau is required to determine whether each selected applicant has demonstrated that it has the technical and financial qualifications to successfully complete the proposed project within the required timeframes and is in compliance with all statutory and regulatory requirements for the universal service support that the applicant seeks.⁶ We emphasize that selected bidders are required to deliver the required minimum speeds to all locations within the funded census blocks.⁷

Attachment B provides instructions for these entities on how to complete FCC Form 5620 and upload their post-selection review attachments. The identified bidders are required, within 10 business days of this Public Notice, to submit the most recent three consecutive years of audited financial statements, including balance sheets, net income, and cash flow, and to submit a description of the technology and system design used to deliver voice and broadband service, including a network diagram, which must be certified by a professional engineer.⁸ Entities proposing to use wireless technologies also must provide a description of spectrum access in the areas for which the applicant seeks support.⁹ The bidders identified in Attachment A are required to submit these materials by **Friday, December 19, 2014 at 11:59p.m. EST**. Failure to submit the requested materials by this deadline will constitute a default, and the bidder will no longer be considered for the identified rural broadband experiment.

Finally, we note that three bidders that initially appeared on the provisionally selected bidders list for funding category one submitted project bids that were facially non-compliant with the requirements

for this category.¹⁰ Those three bidders were removed from consideration, and the FCC Auction System produced the provisionally selected bidders shown on Attachment A.

One of these bidders, ViaSat, Inc., sought a waiver of the Commission's 100 millisecond (ms) latency standard for categories one and two. We deny ViaSat's waiver request for the rural broadband experiments, without prejudice to ViaSat's submission of this request into the docket for further consideration for the Phase II competitive bidding process that will occur to the extent price cap carriers decline the offer of Phase II model-based support. We are not convinced that ViaSat has demonstrated that special circumstances warrant a deviation of the rural broadband experiment rules established for categories one and two, and that waiving the rules for categories one and two would serve the public interest.¹¹ ViaSat's petition raises issues that warrant further consideration with public input for the Phase II competitive bidding process, which remains pending, but we conclude that waiving one of the core requirements for one bidder in the rural broadband experiments without public input after the close of the filing window would be prejudicial to the integrity of the competitive bidding process.¹²

LIFELINE SERVICES TRIBAL LANDS LIFELINE AND LINK-UP SERVICES

The Lifeline Telephone Assistance Program, Tribal Lands Lifeline and Link-Up Programs make residential telephone services more affordable for qualifying low-income households throughout Michigan. Qualifying low-income households receive reduced charges on their monthly telephone bill. Qualifying low-income households residing on a federally recognized reservation receive reduced charges on their monthly telephone bill and reduced installation charges.

Program Benefits

Lifeline: Reduced Monthly Charges - Households participating in the Lifeline Program receive a monthly discount on their local telephone service charges. In most cases, the discount is \$11.25 per month. For customers aged 65 or older, a discount of \$12.35 per month applies. Tribal Lands Lifeline participants receive a monthly discount of approximately \$30 on their local telephone bill.

Link-Up: Reduced Local Telephone Line Installation Charges for Tribal Lands Customers Only - Pursuant to the Tribal Lands Link-Up Program, a qualifying customer is eligible for a 100% reduction (up to \$100) on local telephone line installation service charges.

Option to Elect Toll Blocking in Lieu of Service Deposit - Consumers have the option of blocking outgoing long distance toll calls free of charge. If the applicant elects this option, the local telephone company will not collect a service deposit in order to initiate Lifeline service.

Eligibility

- Applicant's household income does not exceed 150% of current federal poverty standards. Documentation of income is required or
- Proof of participation in one of the following programs: • Food Stamps • Medicaid • Supplemental Security Income (SSI) • Low-Income Home Energy Plan (LIHEAP) • Federal Public Housing Assistance or Section 8 • Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) • National School Lunch - Free Lunch Program
- Tribal Lands customers may be eligible if they live on a federally recognized reservation and participate in one of the programs listed above or the Bureau of Indian Affairs general assistance; Tribally administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families; Head Start (only those households meeting its income qualifying standard); or the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations.

The maximum income amount varies according to the number of people in the household. The application must be completed by the person in whose name the phone is listed, and the phone number listed must be the applicant's primary residence. Regulations established by the Federal Communications Commission prohibit any household from receiving more than one Lifeline discount and Lifeline customers will be asked to verify their continued eligibility for the program on a regular basis.
