Application filed November 4, 2015, and an amended application filed November 12, 2015, for approval of an interconnection agreement and the first amendment to the interconnection agreement (amends the Oklahoma Agreement to add fifteen additional AT&T Inc.-owned companies, including AT&T Michigan; terminates the interconnection agreements presently in effect between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC, and these fifteen companies; adds terms and conditions to implement the Lifeline and Link Up Reform and Modernization <i>et al.</i> , WC Docket No. 11-42 <i>et al.</i> , Second Report |

and Order, FCC 15-71, released June 22, 2015; modifies certain provisions related to Customer Information Services; and updates BCN Telecom, Inc.'s Notice Contact information).

47 USC 252(e)(2) and (3) provides in part:

- (2) The State commission may only reject
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) of this section if it finds that--
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; . . .

- (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (2), but subject to section 253 of this title, nothing in this section shall prohibit a State commission from establishing or enforcing other requirements of State law in its review of an agreement, including requiring compliance with intrastate telecommunications service quality standards or requirements.

After reviewing the applications, the Commission finds that they should be approved. The Commission finds that the agreements and amendments are consistent with federal and state law and are in the public interest. Under 47 USC 252(i) and MCL 484.2359(2), the services provided under the agreements shall be made available to other telecommunications carriers upon the same terms and conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The interconnection agreements and amendments listed above are approved.

- B. Approval of the interconnection agreements and amendments does not alter the duty of the parties to comply with relevant federal and state law and past and future Commission orders and rules.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court under 47 USC 252(e)(6). To comply with the requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
