ORDER

On January 28, 1992, the Commission issued an order in Case No. U-10054 to effectuate 1991 PA 179, the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, directing all telecommunications providers of basic local exchange service to file a copy of the license authorizing the carrier to provide basic local exchange service in this state, or if one did not exist, to indicate such. On August 14, 1992, in that docket, the Commission issued new licenses to providers of basic local exchange service, including Chippewa County Telephone Company (Chippewa), as of January 1, 1992. In 2014, pursuant to a merger, Chippewa County Telephone Company transferred the assets it used to provide basic local exchange service to its affiliate, Hiawatha Telephone Company (Hiawatha), which was granted a permanent license to provide basic local exchange service in the Brimley exchange in the November 24, 2014 Commission

order in Case No. U-17706. On June 4, 2015, Chippewa informed the Commission of its intent to surrender the license of Chippewa County Telephone Company, as the company no longer provides basic local exchange service and its former customers are now being served by Hiawatha.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

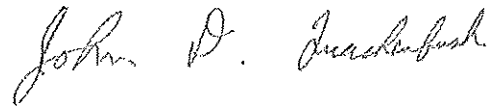
A. The license of Chippewa County Telephone Company to provide basic local exchange service is rescinded.

B. Chippewa County Telephone Company shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

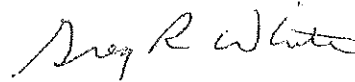
The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 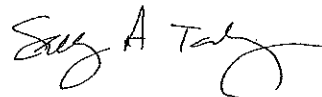

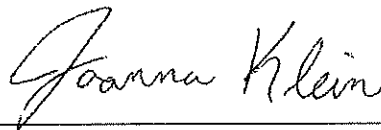
