ORDER

The following parties have filed joint applications for approval of interconnection agreements
or amendments to an interconnection agreement:

Case No. U-13985 AT&T Michigan and Global Connection Inc. of America
Application filed May 17, 2019, for approval of a sixth amendment
to the interconnection agreement (adds terms and conditions to
implement the Connect America Fund et al., WC Docket No. 10-90
et al., Report and Order, FCC 11-161, issued November 18, 2011,
and FCC 11-189, amended on December 23, 2011; updates the
Notices provisions; and implements a name change for Global
Connection).

Case No. U-17113 AT&T Michigan and Daystarr LLC
Application filed May 14, 2019, for approval of a first amendment to
the interconnection agreement (adds terms and conditions to
implement the Connect America Fund et al., WC Docket No. 10-90
et al., Report and Order, FCC 11-161, issued November 18, 2011,
and FCC 11-189, amended on December 23, 2011).

Case No. U-20562

Midway Telephone Company and Charter Fiberlink – Michigan, LLC

Application filed May 21, 2019, for approval of a first amendment to the interconnection agreement (adds additional rate centers and updates certain terms to conform to more recent similar agreements entered into between Charter Fiberlink – Michigan, LLC, and telecommunications service providers in Michigan).

47 USC 252(e)(2) and (3) provides in part:

- (2) The State commission may only reject
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) of this section if it finds that--
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity;

- (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (2), but subject to section 253 of this title, nothing in this section shall prohibit a State commission from establishing or enforcing other requirements of State law in its review of an agreement, including requiring compliance with intrastate telecommunications service quality standards or requirements.

After reviewing the applications, the Commission finds that they should be approved. The Commission finds that the agreements and amendments are consistent with federal and state law and are in the public interest. Under 47 USC 252(i) and MCL 484.2359(2), the services provided under the agreements shall be made available to other telecommunications carriers upon the same terms and conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The interconnection agreements and amendments listed above are approved.

- B. Approval of the interconnection agreements and amendments does not alter the duty of the parties to comply with relevant federal and state law and past and future Commission orders and rules.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court under 47 USC 252(e)(6). To comply with the requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
