Dear Ms. Felice:

In accordance with MCL 460.9t and the Michigan Public Service Commission's ("MPSC" or the "Commission") Orders in Case No. U-17377, Consumers Energy Company ("Consumers Energy" or the "Company") has determined that it will participate in implementing a low-income energy assistance funding factor within its service territory for the billing months of September 2021 through August 2022. Along with this notice of participation Consumers Energy is also providing the Commission with the number of electric meters to which the low-income funding factor will apply as required by MCL 460.9t(8).

Consumers Energy's meter count of 1,861,992 represents the number of residential, commercial, and industrial retail electric meters for both full service and choice customers as of May 2021. In addition, as required by MCL 460.9t(10), this residential meter count does not include more than one (1) meter per residential site.
